1. Introduction

Nadalini Global, Inc. ("NGI," "we," "us," or "our") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the personal and business data you share with us. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and protect your information when you visit our website, utilize our intake forms, or engage with our logistics services.

By using our website, you consent to the data practices described in this policy.

2. What We Collect

We collect the information you choose to send us through our website intake forms and when you communicate with NGI. This may include:

- **Contact Info:** Name, email address, and phone number.
- **Carrier Identifiers (when applicable):** MC# and DOT#.
- **Shipping / Load Info (when applicable):** Shipment details you submit for quoting and coordination (for example: lanes, dates, pickup/delivery locations, equipment type, weight/commodity, and special handling notes).
- **Basic Website/Device Info:** Limited technical data (like IP address and browser type) needed to keep the site working and secure.

3. Why We Need It

We use the information you submit to:

- **Vet and qualify carriers and partners:** Confirm authority, insurance, and basic compliance so we can protect our customers and our network.
- **Provide quotes and coordinate freight:** Use your shipping details to price, plan, and manage shipments.
- **Filter out bad-fit requests (including "lazy brokerages"):** Our intake forms help us identify who's serious and qualified so we can focus on real shippers, real carriers, and real opportunities.
- **Operate and protect our business:** Help prevent fraud, keep our systems secure, and maintain accurate records.

4. No Spam / Sharing Your Information

NGI does **not** sell your information or send it to random marketing lists.

We only share information when it's needed to get the job done, including:

- **With vetted partners involved in your shipment:** For example, sharing shipment details with a qualified carrier/driver, or sharing limited carrier details with a shipper (and vice versa) to coordinate a load.
- **With service providers that support our operations:** Only as needed (for example, tools used for communication, document handling, or basic website operations).
- **If legally required:** We may disclose information to regulators or law enforcement (such as FMC-SA/DOT) if required by law, or to protect our rights and business.

5. Data Security & Proprietary Protection

NGI implements industry-standard security measures to protect your data. However, as a freight brokerage, we deal with sensitive proprietary information.

- Access to our full onboarding packets and internal documents is restricted to vetted leads to prevent unauthorized use by competitors or unauthorized entities.
- Users are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of any secure-area login credentials provided by NGI.

6. Wire Fraud & Financial Security

NGI will never request changes to payment instructions or banking details via email without a secondary, live-voice verification. We are not responsible for losses resulting from wire fraud initiated by third-party email compromises. Always verify financial changes through our official corporate phone lines.

7. Cookies

We use basic cookies/technical tools that help the website work properly (for example: security, session settings, and basic performance). You can disable cookies in your browser, but parts of the site (including forms) may not work correctly.

8. Your Rights and Choices

Depending on your jurisdiction, you may have the right to:

- Request access to the personal data we hold about you.
- Request the correction of inaccurate data.
- Request the deletion of your data (subject to federal record-keeping requirements for freight brokers).
